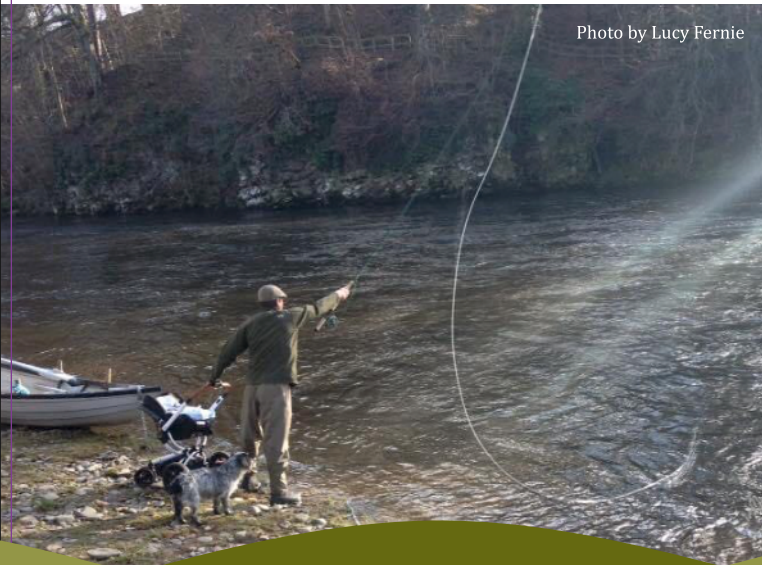
CHAIRMAN OF THE TRUSTEES WRITES...

The Gamekeepers Welfare Trust was originally formed to give financial assistance to keepers in need. With the funds available this usually meant making grants for small items that improved the quality of life for the applicant. While this remains an important part of our work, an equally important element is the provision of a helpline and follow-up assistance to help keepers tackle a variety of problems that they may face. The scope of these problems is spelt out on the pages opposite.

Gamekeeping can be a solitary profession and there may be no-one locally with whom a keeper can discuss their concerns. With the helpline keepers can be confident that they can pick up the phone and speak to someone who understands the particular problems of their job.

The charity is very cost-effective because a caller to the help line can often be pointed in the right direction to unlock the help they need whether financial assistance or other difficulties.
